

# MURDERER VANSTAVERN HAS BROKEN DOWN

Samuel Vanstavern, of Camden, who was sentenced to be hanged April 8 for the murder of his wife Catharine, and whose case will be argued before the Court of Errors and Appeals at Trenton, on Tuesday, broke down and wept like a child in the Camden County Jail yesterday.

During a lull in the business of the County Board of Elections President Joseph W. Engard and Thomas F. Walton made a tour of the jail. On approaching Vanstavern's cell they found him on his knees with a lighted candle on a stool in front of him and clad only in an old undershirt and a ragged pair of trousers. He eagerly sought their views as to the final outcome of his case, and when advised to prepare for the worst gave way completely to his feelings.

He declared he had no fear of death, but it was the future that worried him.
