

CAMDEN NEWS NOTES

** James Dester, aged 30 years, of 793 Lipe street, Camden, was admitted to the Cooper Hospital suffering from many cuts and bruises, the result of being kicked by a mule.

** Rev. Will M. Upcroft, a native Chinaman, spoke at the North Baptist Church last night. He appeared in the costume of his country and spoke of his work as a missionary in Western China.

** Chicken thieves carried away eight valuable fowls from the hen roost in the rear of the home of George Koppyon, at 2738 Harrison avenue, East Side, at an early hour yesterday morning.

** The Camden police yesterday made several raids on gangs of crap shooters, but most of the participants were too elusive to be captured. Policemen Lovett, Cattell and Guthridge each made an arrest.

** Policeman W. J. Todd has been transferred from the East Side to the First Police district of Camden, and Policeman Benjamin Middleton, of the First district, to the East Side. The transfers took effect last night.

** James Andrews, aged 8 years, of 719 Jayne street, Camden, was seriously injured about the head by being knocked down by a bicyclist near his home. Andrews was thrown violently to the ground and was picked up unconscious. He was taken to the Cooper Hospital.

** William Redwood, colored, aged 28 years, narrowly escaped asphyxiation at the coke works, foot of Chestnut street, yesterday. He was found near one of the ovens in an unconscious condition. A record run was made to the Cooper Hospital, where prompt action saved his life.

** Rev. Abel Dixon, of the Church of God and Saints of Christ, of Philadelphia, yesterday afternoon baptized one person, a colored man, in the Delaware River at the foot of Germantown street, East Side. The ceremony was performed in the presence of a large number of people.

** During the razing of the big circus tent at Haddon and Kalghn avenues Camden, early yesterday morning, Matthew Kuhlra, of 2217 South Rosewood street, Philadelphia, was struck on the head by a falling pole. He was taken to the Cooper Hospital, where it was found he had sustained severe bruises and lacerations.
