CAMDEN BOY AMONG INJURED IN FRANCE

James A. McGuckin Is Men- tioned in Cable as Being Wounded Among Marines

James A. McGuckin, of 1002 Line street, Camden, is named among the severely wounded in the casualties among the marines cabled from France yesterday. He is 31 years old and is the son of Mrs. Mary McGuckin, a widow. "He was such a good boy," said Mrs. McGuckin yesterday as tears rolled down her cheeks. "Oh, if I could only be with him to nurse him. We are all proud of Jim and will pray that his life be spared."

McGuckin has been in the service several years. He has done duty in the tropics and was with Pershing in Mexico. He was home last Thanksgiving.

Lieutenant Robert Elliott Surtees, son of Rev. J. L. Surtees, a former Camden pastor and now stationed at Millville, is in a hospital in Genoa, Italy, with a shattered right leg. He is in the Canadian Army.
